Objectives:

- Evaluate how events in America's history have affected housing design.
- Compare and contrast housing styles in the 18th century.
- Compare and contrast housing styles in the 19th century.
- Evaluate historical housing elements that influenced 20th century signs
- Analyze the unique housing designs of the late 20th and early 21st century.
