

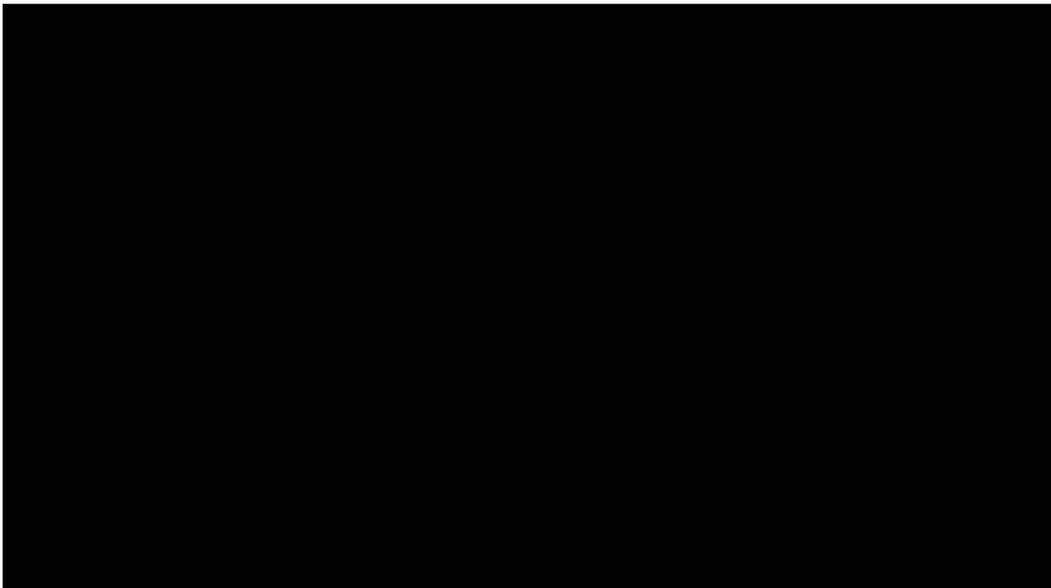
# Signing Into Adobe Creative Cloud Express

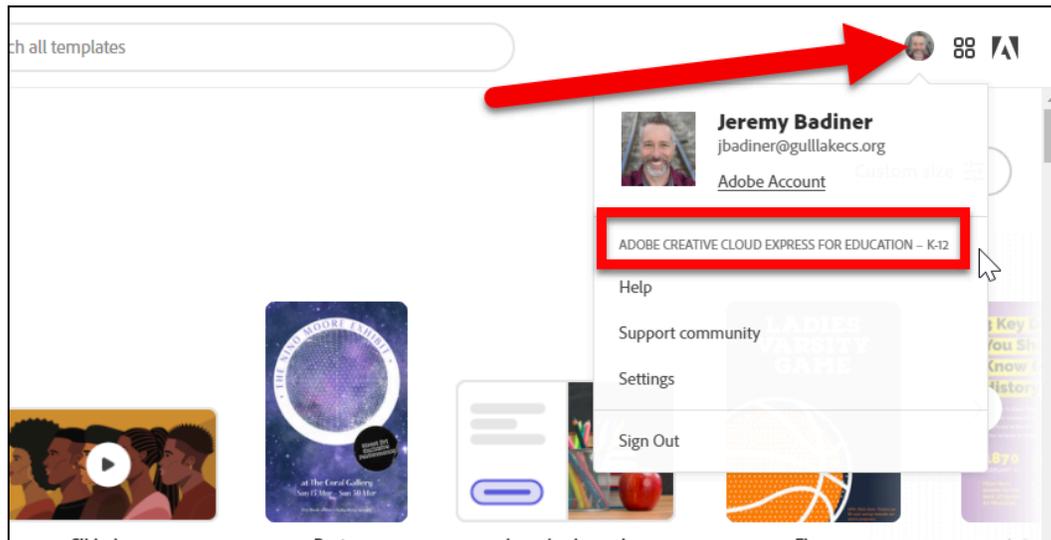
## Sign Into Creative Cloud Express with your Enterprise Account:

1. Head to [express.adobe.com/sp/](https://express.adobe.com/sp/).
2. Click "**Sign In**".
3. Choose "**Continue with Google**".
4. Choose "**Enterprise ID**" (*This will show up if your account is tied to a set-up Enterprise account. If your district did not set these up you will not have all the features of the K-12 accounts...for free...Get your admin to set up Adobe accounts*).



# Make sure you are in Your Enterprise/School Account:

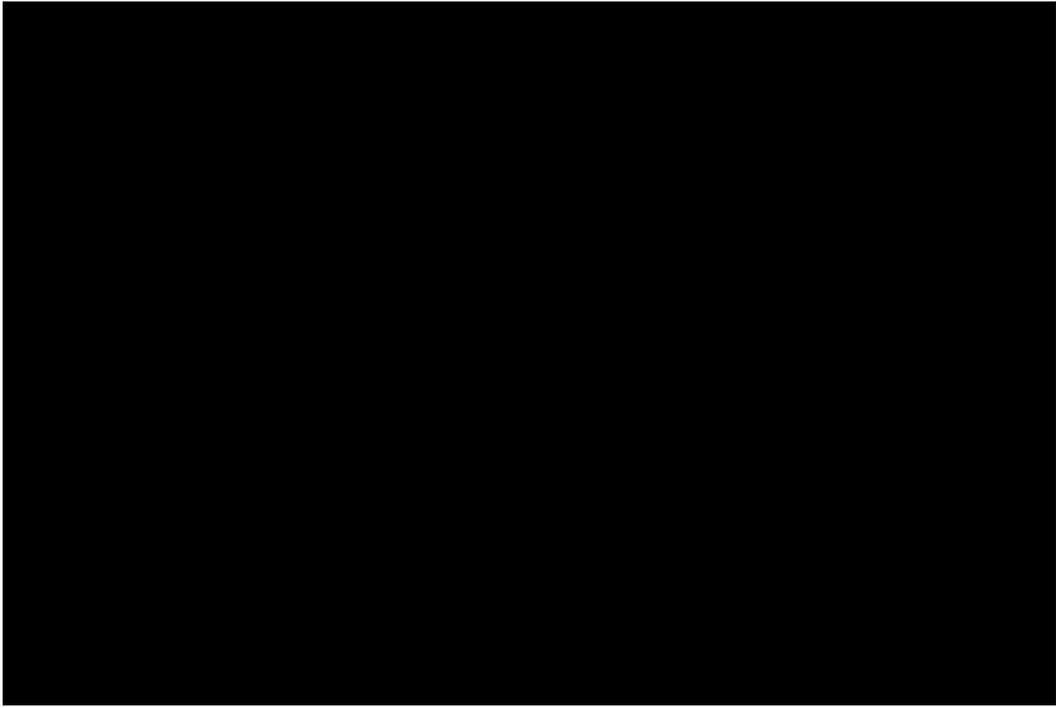
Make sure to check that you have the Premium Version. Click on your account icon in the top right and look for "**Adobe Creative Cloud Express for Education**".



If you do not see "**Adobe Creative Cloud Express for Education**" you may need to sign in with the steps below. I had that issue because I already had an Adobe account set to my Gull Lake email. I had to sign in once as an "**Enterprise**" account. Follow these steps one time:

1. Sign out of Adobe Express if you are already signed in.
2. Head to [express.adobe.com/sp/](https://express.adobe.com/sp/).
3. Click "**Sign In**".
4. Choose "**Log in with school account**".
5. Choose "**Continue with Google**".
6. Choose "**Enterprise ID**".
7. You are ready to Create!
