Tips for Designers:

- 1. Make sure people can instantly see your work and links on social media. If a link to your commission information or samples of your work aren't instantly visible, people might click out of the tab. For example, A pinned tweet with links to your folio/store/ alongside images of your work is perfect, all easily accessible as soon as they open your page. You can also put your work in a banner, or at the very least have a prominent link to your portfolio.
- 2. Similarly, try to make it the shortest route possible for people to go from one site to another, not an endless trail of links. Again, if people are trying to find your commission prices and they have to click through 5 links to get there, they'll likely give up and look for another artist. Link aggregator sites are useful for this.
- 3. Anytime you have big accomplishments, get positive feedback, or compliments on your work, screenshot it and save it to a folder. Good to look at whenever you're feeling negative about your art or imposter-syndrome-y. It's a good reminder that you've made people happy with things YOU created.
- 4. If getting paid via Paypal (or other services with the function) always send Invoices instead of "friends and family" requests. This not only gives you more of a professional look, but allows for more safety regarding refunds and price changes. I also highly suggest always enabling tips on invoices, you never know who will be willing to pay a little bit extra!
