To provide a valuable starting point to navigating your post-high school options, [YOUR HIGH SCHOOL] is participating in a new state program called Direct Admissions. What to expect:

- **You will receive your personalized Direct Admissions letter**
This letter will list the names of each participating college and university that is offering you admission to their institution in fall 2025. There are over 50 Minnesota colleges and universities that are participating in the Direct Admissions program, including a full range of community, technical, tribal, public and private institutions. As part of the Direct Admissions program, all application fees for participating colleges and universities are waived, so it is FREE to apply to any of the institutions on your list!
- **Confirm your colleges and universities to receive Direct Admission**
Your next step is to confirm which colleges and universities that you would like to receive Direct Admission to. Submit your digital letter back to your high school, answer the questions in the application portal, and you will receive your official acceptance letters. In some cases, colleges and universities will request additional application information. Watch your email inbox for a message from the colleges and universities for your next steps.
