- Go to the website of the college or university you are applying to and complete the online application. Links to most Michigan colleges can be found <u>HERE</u>
- Submit your transcript electronically using **Parchment**.
- <u>SAT</u> and <u>ACT</u> scores must be sent to colleges directly from the testing agency. After you've been admitted, you will need to send your <u>AP Exam</u> scores as well.
- If your application requires a letter of recommendation from a teacher, identify someone who can write on your behalf and allow a minimum of two weeks for the letter to be completed.
