## **DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT**

Teaching English as a Foreign Language is a challenging process, especially when very young learners with very little linguistic competence are involved. Learning to read and write in a Foreign Language is not easy. English is a germanic language which makes use of the latin alphabet to write the spoken language. Children at the first grade of Primary get really stressed when learning how to read and write in English, so involving students in creating a dictionary becomes an interesting approach for them to practise these skills.

Also, having the opportunity to contact teachers and students from other countries is a fantastic chance for our students and for us, as teachers: knowing other cultural realities, meeting other people from abroad is always a rewarding experience and makes us aware of the importance of English as a lingua franca in the world.

So, this is a simple description about what, how and why we are starting this experience in eTwinning.

### **OBJECTIVES**

1	Improve our students' communicative competence in English throughout the activities and materials planned for this eTwinning Project: Reading and Writing.
2	Enjoy the process of exchanging communicative messages among the people involved in the project.
3	Appreciate and value positively diversity and other social and cultural realities in order to raise awareness of tolerance and respect.
4	Learn the basic vocabulary which is suitable for their age and level.
5	Learn basic knowledge about another country and valuate the diversity and cooperation from students from abroad.
6	Develop artistic expression to represent the words included in the dictionary.
7	Valuate the involvement in the project as an individual, as a group and as the project itself.
8	Develop IT competences throughout the activities.

The idea is to create a picture dictionary with the basic words to learn. This document will be converted into pdf so students of anywhere can use it to improve their linguistic competence in English.

Each student will have to draw the object or the action, and write the names of the word in both capital letters and lower case. The teachers will scan each page and create the final document with the contributions of all the students involved. So, it will be a cooperative work.

We (students and teachers) will also create an information board about the project for the school in order to show the whole process.

Also, it will be necessary to create a presentation about how the sequences and activities are being carried out, in order to promote this kind of project in our school communities and inform families and teachers about how English is being taught as a communicative language in an European context.

FEBRUARY and MARCH	<ol> <li>Drawing and writing the pages: definitive work.</li> <li>Scanning the pages ( teachers will scan each worksheet made by the students ).</li> <li>Final design and creation of the pdf document: teachers will do it online, using a Google Drive to share the definitive document, and its conversion to pdf.</li> </ol> TEST: Worksheet.
APRIL and MAY	<ol> <li>Upload the document on the web. We will use: eTwinning Live, Twinspace, School webpage, and other social networks.</li> <li>Creation of a Google Presentation of the process of the Project in order to promote the eTwinning experience and inform the respective school communities of the task done.</li> </ol>
