

Py Bellamy Village official book of law and order.

clarifications,

when referring to manager we mean prime minister

Bellamy Village is not a real country and is in the borders of the US, we may not commit any US crimes.

article I - government structure

Bellamy village is a direct democracy, meaning that the citizens can vote for anything that the manager puts up for vote if they are over 13.

the administrative Council decides if a non-electoral vote should be put up, and which people should be in for electoral votes

no manager may be corrupt, meaning they can't have more power than the citizens unless an uncontrollable situation is happening nor No manager may build derogatory or prison camps for any person not being harm to the people and set a tax above 20% and not have a minimum wage under \$15.25 (122 bells)

the manager may not tweak or change the government system in any way unless approved by the people (voting system)

the people have more power than the manager, the manager may not vote nor make a decision that wasn't voted (unless it's something personal or is a purchase toward the government not using tax money)

the manager must follow every law

elections happen every three years, the people may not vote twice, buy other slips or cause destruction over political differences.

the manager may not be biased, racist, sexist or homophobic, the manager also can't lie or tell white lies nor refer to something else while sounding like they're talking about the same topic.

To vote people must collect a slip, fill it out, wait in line and then put it into the box, the slips will be collected at the end of voting, no online influence may convince the citizens. They may also vote online

there's two types of votes, Non-electoral votes and electoral-votes, the electoral-votes will be held every three years on Oct 2nd and are only for manager voting, non-electoral voting is for community projects and decisions.

article II - restricted and banned items and actions

For the safety and well-being of the citizens of Bellamy Village, certain substances and actions are hereby restricted or banned within all Bellamy Village territories.

The following substances are strictly prohibited: a. Marijuana and cannabis-based recreational substances.

Fentanyl, heroin, salvia, and any substances classified as highly dangerous or addictive.

Any substance containing Red 40 food dye.

Exceptions may only be granted for medical, scientific, or educational purposes, and must be approved through a public vote or lawful authorization set by the Manager.

The Bellamy Village government reserves the right to add or remove restricted items through direct democratic vote of the citizens.

Enforcement of this article must respect citizen rights and shall not involve excessive punishment or collective penalties.

No person may use Methamphetamine for any reason because it may be harmful.

no person may bring raw lumber for fire or other reasons over the border of Bellamy village unless authorized or treated.

article III - monopoly restrictions

no company may own more than 6% of the market

no company may buy, merge or require other companies within Bellamy

no company shall overthrow this law at all even if they are a foreign entity, family owned business or if they are an affiliated company.

A company shall not impose an unreasonable price on any item, which is defined as a price exceeding 180% of the item's manufacturing cost.

article IV - harm, safety and public conduct

no person may commit arson or do any form of vandalism, meaning people may not burn property nor destroy it in any way or paint over property.

no person may have a gun of any type unless they are a government worker including officers, firefighters, authorized hunters or spy agents.

no person may cause harm to any person unless in a sport such as wrestling or boxing even if given consent.

no person may cause a commotion by; yelling, faking a threat or using fake weapons

article V - citizenship

a person may be granted citizenship if; the Prime Minister gives citizenship, if the person gets accepted by a form

a citizen may get their citizenship restricted if; they commit a crime too many times, repeatedly make people interested, or interfere with government business unless they are part of the government or are protesting.

article VI - rights and freedom

a person may say anything or say something about anyone, unless it is sexist or racist.

you may peacefully protest, no violence is allowed.

guns are not allowed like mentioned in article IV

people of any age over 13 are allowed to vote for anything or anyone (for Non-electoral and electoral)

anyone is allowed is allowed to vote for Non-electoral votes

anything can be sold or bought, as long as the buyer and seller agree. including land and anything purchasable

People may not cut down trees or destroy anything unless it's granted by the government. The list of cuttable trees without permission are; thorn trees, thorn bushes, grass, any building that is abandoned and not for sale and is not owned. crops, your own plants in your land.

article VII - justice system

This article is for the laws and decisions made through non-electoral votes. The vote has to be at least 50% on either side to be passed, unless said by the government.
