LESSON TITLE: The Astronaut Who Painted the Moon	LESSON GOAL: The students will create a multi-media moon art craft.
INTRODUCE THE BOOK/STORY: (Read the story or use the video link.)	VIDEO BOOK LINK: <u>The Astronaut Who Painted the Moon</u> by Dean Robbins & Sean Rubin
DISCUSSION QUESTIONS: (Check for Understanding)	 What did Alan and Pete push into the dust of the moon? Was Alan able to bounce around the moon? What did Alan do to show the magic and mystery of the moon?
SUPPLIES NEEDED: White construction paper, black construction paper or black glitter construction paper (optional), white Sharpie paint marker, collage items, glue, washi tape	ACTIVITY INTRODUCTION: What do you see when you look at the moon? What do you think of? Our project today is make a picture of the moon using different items.
ACTIVITY (Students should do their work):	Washi Tape Moon craft
CLOSING DISCUSSION: (Review activity through discussion or questions).	Did you like the way your moon art turned out? Here is a short video with Fun Moon Facts
GROUP GAME: Developmental Goal: Awareness development. Equipment Needed: None	 Read through the game instructions ahead of time so that you can teach the activity. Use an attention-getter to gather students and make sure they are listening. Explain the game, the rules, and how to play the game. Check for understanding, have a few kids and staff demonstrate play. Link to game: Red Light, Green Light
