11 players on each team

Game consists of 2 innings

This is an illustration of the PITCH which is centered in the field

wicket	"BOWLER" (pitcher)	wicket
--------	-----------------------	--------

Batting Team:

- 2 Batsmen (term for batter in cricket) are on the field at a time
- Tries to score runs by running back and forth between wickets (both batters must make it safely)
- Can hit anywhere in the field
- Each time a batter is out, the next batter replaces
- Batters take turns until all batters have had a turn

Fielding Side

- Bowler is the "pitcher"
- All other players are scattered around the pitch
- Terms for outs:
 - o "CAUGHT" catching a fly ball
 - o "BOWLED" bowler (pitcher) gets the ball past the batter and hits the wicket
 - o "STUMPED" a fielder hits the wicket with the ball before the batter scores the run
