- You need to RSVP to all workshops and events, including required workshops.

- There are limited spaces available per event, so you are strongly encouraged to RSVP as soon as possible to secure your spot.
- Please make sure only to select WOW events that do not conflict with the required workshops you're invited to.

# Step 1: Go to stonybrook.edu/sbengaged

Select 'Sign in' in top right corner



- As you view the details for each session, click 'Add to Google Calendar | iCal/Outlook' under the date and time. The image below, for example, purposes only.




## **OPTION 4 TO ACCESS YOUR REQUIRED WORKSHOPS:**

Download the CORQ App and select "MY" Events. All events that you have been assigned to and/or RSVP'd to will appear here.




# Step 3: Day-of Access

 At the respective dates/times of your workshops, you will arrive at your workshop location and check in with your event pass. See the image below on how to access your event pass.




# How to access SBU Weeks of Welcome (WOW) events in SB Engaged:
