c. OAOA – Jack/Debi

- i. Jack = Understandable that games are being canceled, PIL requiring officials to wear masks (hard with a whistle).
- ii. Football typically has 670 officials, but things are looking better. Here are the numbers:

Volleyball	283	346	
Soccer	383	390?	

Basketball	632	860	over 1000
Wrestling	89	160	180

- iii. Wrestling: All day events on weekdays are extremely hard to cover due to work. That is something that should be avoided.
- iv. Debi = A lot of new officials. Please remind coaches/ADs that new officials will not be veterans overnight. Chewing them out or yelling at them is not going to help them stay.
- v. Jack = Please be proactive to stop racial slurs at games. It's not the officials job to listen to the crowd. If heard, it is addressed, but game management and supervision need to help with this as well.

d. Treasurer – Toni

- i. Checking \$58,728.30. \$30,000 was moved to a Vanguard investment account.
- ii. Still owe a little to NIAAA for dual membership dues.
- iii. more and more memberships are coming in.
