

Event Bathroom Description Policy

As outlined in our <u>DiscNY Guidelines for Gender Inclusion</u>, all DiscNY programs must include information about the location's bathroom availability and signage. Because safe and equal bathroom access is a fundamental human right, as well as the law of the land in New York City, every New Yorker has a right to use the bathroom consistent with their gender identity, regardless of their gender assigned at birth. It has been illegal in New York City to discriminate against an individual on the basis of gender identity or expression, including denying access to bathrooms, since the <u>2002 NYC Human Rights Law.</u> In 2016, as outlined in the <u>Mayor's 2016 executive order:</u> all members of the public must be allowed to use the single-sex facility that most closely aligns with their gender identity and expression, without being required to show identification, medical documentation, or any other form or proof of verification of gender. Thus, regardless of the signage of bathrooms at NYC fields and parks, anyone of any gender identity is legally able to use whichever bathroom they choose.

DiscNY Program Bathrooms

BROOKLYN

Brooklyn Bridge Park Pier 5

Bathrooms are located near Fornino's Pizza at Brooklyn Bridge Park and are labeled with men, women, and an all-gender disclaimer plaque.

Sternberg Park

There are no unlocked bathrooms on the premises after dark. During the day, the bathrooms are multi-stall, designated with "women's" and "men's" signs.

Mccarren Park

McCarren Park's new bathrooms are labeled as "all gender". Water fountains are available around the McCarren track.

Prospect Park Parade Grounds

The bathrooms at Prospect Park Parade Grounds are multi-stall, designated with 'women's' and 'men's' signs.

Red Hook:

The bathrooms at Red Hook are multi-stall, and labeled as 'women's' and 'men's.

MANHATTAN

Harlem River Park

There are no unlocked bathrooms on the premises.

Pier 40

The bathrooms are multi-stall, designated with 'women's' and 'men's' signs.

Chelsea Park

<u>The bathrooms</u> are located at [West 27 Street & 9 Avenue] and are designated with 'women's' and 'men's' signs.

Gansevoort

Bathroom hut with' men's and 'women's' right at the field entrance. Bathrooms are open till Midnight

QUEENS

Astoria Park

Park bathrooms are located next to the track and are multi-stall designated with 'women's' and 'men's' signs. (Bathrooms generally close before 7:30pm)

QBK Sports

The bathrooms at QBK Sports are single-stall, designated with 'all gender' signs.

Randall's Island

The bathrooms are multi-stall designated with 'women's' and 'men's' signs.

BRONX

Van Cortlandt Park

Park bathrooms are located next to the Nature Center designated with 'women's' and 'men's' signs.
