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—RATIONALE—

Since 610-2 are protective over the the core would they be able to notice a CD attacking it/going directly towards it without directly seeing them and being preoccupied with chasing other CDs.

And if so would it abandon the majority of CDs to chase that one going for the core?

—METHOD—

Setting Up

To begin with (After CDs were gathered, briefed and we were outside 610s CC.) all boxes were brought to MCZ, as HCZ has a HEAVY lack of tables and such. When that was done our C9 got us into an STS and briefed all of us, after that I was ready to brief the CDs.

Briefing and Assigning CDs

CDs were all lined up separately as the original STS was quite messy and unorganized so they were taken a bit further away and I briefed there. They were told that all of them would be taking 207 and one of them would have 2398 equipped, after that I explained why each is being used.

Next I chose a singular CD called mokes60 to be the bat holder, I explained that his job was to lay back and run while the doors were being opened, when the coast was clear he'd run all the way to the Core and attack it in intervals of 2 seconds, after that was clear the rest were briefed.

Their brief was much simpler, as the doors are being opened they are to try their best to guide 610 away from the bat holder by being bait and while entering and waiting, to STS in front of the bat holder too, to ensure they were seen first, after a few questions everything was understood and we moved on.

Intermission

In this section CDs were taken over to MCZ in order to take the required SCP items, before they left though, miemper and I both put Cameras on the bat holder so we could view what happens, after around 5 to 8 minutes they came back with all the effects and the bat in mokes' hands. We were able to continue from there and send 'em in.

Sending In the CDs

I got the CDs lined up at the entrance to the Containment Chamber and gave them another brief, same exact as the last but shortened and easier for them to understand. I went over to the Viewing



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Area and spectated from the Camera in order to see what was going on.

The Test

When the Test began, all the CDs did as they were told, 610-2 was guided away from the bat holder, using that opportunity mokes60 (bat-holder) ran straight for the core and swung at it repeatedly in the intervals he was told (once every 2 seconds).

After seeing mokes60 swinging repeatedly, i took the chance to look at what 610-2 was doing from the window and oddly enough, 610-2 kept trying to get closer to the Core but every 2 seconds would retreat for a bit.

Eventually when 610-2 did make it into there, it saw the CD swinging at the Core, 610 kept trying to get closer and couldn't as every 2 seconds it would get scared or get hurt in some way causing it to retreat.

—RESULTS—

- The CDs executed their roles effectively, with the bat holder (mokes60) attacking the core at regular intervals.
- Despite 610-2's attempts to approach the core, it was repeatedly deterred, possibly due to the bat holder attacking causing it to retreat every two seconds.
- 610-2 showed hesitation or fear in approaching the core, showing susceptibility to distractions or threats posed by the bat holder's attacks.

Conclusion:

The test showed that SCP-610-2 can be influenced by threats towards the core, such as repeated attacks on the core by someone. This behavior explains exactly why 610-2 is protective over the core in the first place.

More tests will come to explore the extent to which SCP-610-2 can be manipulated or deterred from its objectives or CDs through the Core being under attack.

Overall, the test provided really REALLY good knowledge into the behavior of SCP-610-2 and how it is connected to the Core. In containment breaches, this could possibly be used to stop 610-2 from going into places and helping recontain it.

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
