Example	Charlie & Mya sell cars. Mya earns \$200 for each car she sells. At the end of the week, Charlie earned \$800 less than Mya. The following expression shows: $200x - 800$. In the expression, what does the first term represent?	C. The number of cars Mya sold	D. Mya's earning at the end of the week	When I read the question I thought it was asking what the variable x represented, which is how many cars Mya sold in a week. What the question was asking was what does the term $200x$, when the 200 & x are put together mean. The 200 is how much Mya makes for each car she sells and x is how many cars she sells in a week. Together the terms represent Mya's earnings at the end of the week.
