Introduction

Text can be written in Indonesian or English. The manuscript submitted to the editors must be the final manuscript in MS Word format that has been adapted to the writing guidelines and styles of the Elkawnie journal so that the manuscript can be directly displayed and printed. Text is typed using **12 Times New Roman** fonts, line spacing of **1.15**. The text area is **A4** paper size, 11.5 cm wide and 22 cm high, including headers and footers. For example, (Kowalski, 2014). When more than one reference is cited within the same sentence, please format the citation as follows (Ngolemasango et al., 2003; Roberts, 1988).

Prepare your text at least six pages and a **maximum of 14 pages** (if possible and the editor agrees based on considerations of scientific development that are considered important, more pages are permitted), including references.

Direct quotes of Arabic text written with flat left and right margins. Give a left indent of 1.2 pt.

Procedure

Methods already published should be indicated with a reference; only relevant modifications should be described.

Sub procedure

For theoretical or computational works, this Methodology may be modified into Computational Details, including the Software, Algorithms, Equations, etc. It is not necessary to include the Materials or Instruments for a sole theoretical/computational work.

Results and Discussion

The findings should be presented in this section. The actual results and discussion must be supported by schemes, figures, graphs, tables, reactions, and equations, all of which should be clearly numbered. Schemes, chemical structures, and graphs must be prepared using **ChemDraw**, **Origin**, or other similar software.

All tables and figures must include a title or caption and a legend to ensure they are self-explanatory. Furthermore, equations should be written using the Equation Editor. Graphs, diagrams, or curves generated in Excel must be inserted in an editable format. All figures and tables should be appropriately cited within the discussion.




Fig 1. Example for image (10 pt) of (a)., (b)., and (c). etc.




Fig 2. Example for graphic (Times New Roman, 10 pt)

Place the chart label below the image, leaving one space between the image and its label. An example of proper image labeling is shown in Figure 2.

Avoid including new data, figures, or references that have not been previously discussed in the manuscript.

In this section, the authors may specify the **individual contributions** of each author as well as the extent and role of any limited assistance obtained from Artificial Intelligence (AI) tools.

Acknowledgements

The *Elkawnie* Journal limits the number of main authors to a **maximum of five**. Additional contributors may be recognized in the Acknowledgements section. In this section, authors may include the **contract number** if the research was supported by a grant and list the names of research members who are not included among the main authors.
