

Dear Second Grade families,

The Christmas season is here and we're excited to share in the Second Grade tradition of singing "The Little Drummer Boy" in Mater Dei's pageant. The pageant is on **Tuesday, December 9 at 1:30 pm and 7:00 pm**.
