

LINWOOD PARK GUEST VISITOR PASS

(Replaces Evening Pass & Dinner Pass programs)

(Not for Use On July 4th)

Purpose: The Guest Visitor Pass is designed to allow Cottage Owners (or their approved cottage occupants) to have guests visit them *at their cottage* without gate fees up to six (6) times during the Season. It is meant for cottage visits only, not to include activity in the Park or Park amenities (such as Beach, athletic venues, pavilion) and not for overnight stays. Visits by Guests and visitors to the Stand and Store are permissible. Each cottage will be allowed up to 6 Evening Passes per Season. The Guest Visitor Pass may be used any day or evening during the Season with the exception of July 4th.

How to use the Evening Pass: The cottage owner or approved occupant must initiate the use of the Pass by calling the Linwood Gate (967-4237) preferably the day of use and giving the guest's name and expected time of arrival. The gate personnel will record the information for the guest's arrival.

When the guest arrives he or she should give his/her name and the cottage owner's name or the cottage address as identification, and the paper gate pass will be given to the driver of the vehicle. The pass is white, labeled Evening Pass Linwood Park, and will have the cottage owner's name and/or address on the reverse side. The gate personnel will direct the guest if necessary.

At the conclusion of the visit the guest should return the pass to the gate for filing and the next use. If the cottage owner or approved occupant wishes, to be certain that the pass is returned to the gate for filing, he/she may return it that evening or the next day.

Each time the pass is used a number will be cut off the lower edge of the pass. Six Evening Passes are given throughout the season for each cottage.
