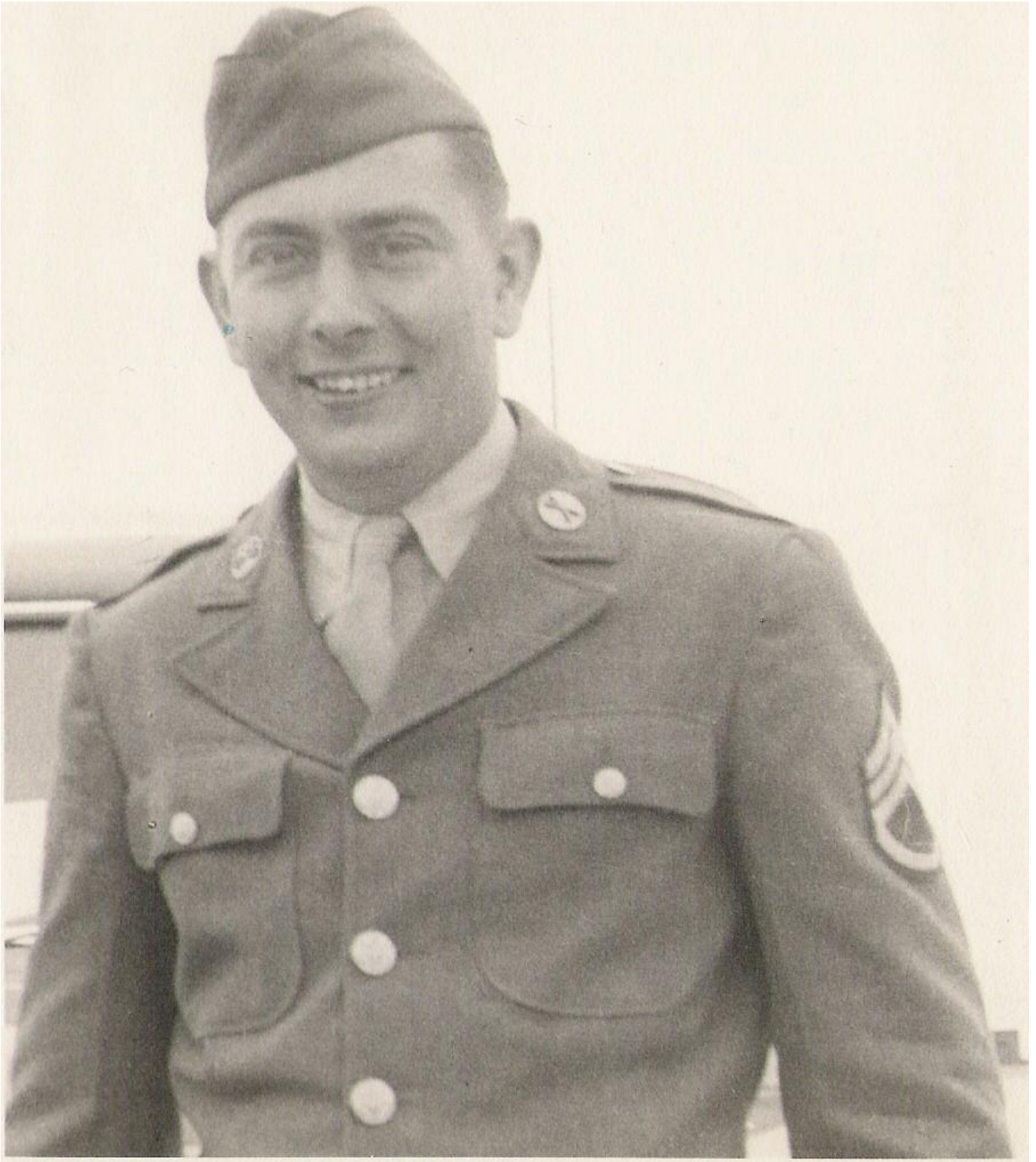

Alvin R. Markofske, 50, of 46 W. 12th Ave., died Sunday at 7 a.m. at the Veterans Hospital, Wood, Wis. He had been there 11 days.

He was born in Montello on June 23, 1918, son of Robert and Minnie Markofske, and came to Oshkosh in 1927. He was a former steamfitter with Robert Gunz, E. C. Merrill and Burdick Co.

Mr. Markofske served with the Army field artillery during World War II. He was a member of Peace Lutheran Church.
