- Teach medical terminology, anatomy, infection control, and daily patient care techniques.
- Guide students through hands-on practice for vital signs, mobility assistance, and hygiene care.
- Maintain a healthy learning environment for the students in both classroom and clinicals.
- Supports classroom management through positive interventions.
- Track student progress, grade coursework, and verify clinical competency .
- Maintain a professional demeanor with students, parents, and colleagues

- Select, store, order, issue, and inventory equipment, materials, and supplies used in the medical careers program.
- Promote and foster the primary goals of the school and the CTE Medical Careers program.
