

No Choice Allowed

For 50 years, the abortion industry and its allies in the so-called “pro-choice” movement told us that women should have a “choice” when it comes to abortion; that women had the “right to choose” whether or not to end a pregnancy.

It has been clear over the years, and is becoming even more clear now, that even though women are supposed to have “choice,” they shouldn’t be allowed to choose life. I’ll give you three categories...

#1 – Informed Consent

Many states have enacted informed consent laws to make sure that women seeking an abortion are fully informed about the abortion procedure, its potential risks, and alternatives — something required for every other surgical procedure performed in the United States. Along with the law, several states required that she be allowed to view an ultrasound of her preborn baby if she wishes to.

The abortion industry has vigorously opposed these laws. They know that if she gets information about her baby and the abortion process, she may very well change her mind. The abortion industry doesn’t want her to know what she’s doing so they oppose any and all attempts to give her information before making that life-or-death decision.

#2 – Abortion Pill Reversal

Abortion proponents have set their sights on another real “choice”: Abortion Pill Reversal (APR).

If a woman starts the abortion pill process but changes her mind about the abortion before taking the second set of pills, she can seek medical help, getting a heavy-dose progesterone treatment to counteract the effect of the mifepristone. The process is effective about 2/3 of the time and more than 7,000 babies are alive because their moms changed their minds and these precious babies survived.

Abortion advocates hate Abortion Pill Reversal, saying it’s “junk science” and doesn’t work.

The very pro-abortion American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, or ACOG, says the abortion reversal procedures are unproven and unethical. Yet, it’s the same treatment many of those same doctors use to help a woman experiencing threatened miscarriage early in pregnancy—a heavy dose of progesterone.

They don't care about the woman who changes her mind and wants to try to save her baby. Their objective is a dead baby.

Colorado has gone so far as to pass a law to charge doctors with "medical misconduct" if they help a woman reverse her chemical abortion.

#3 – Attacks on pregnancy care centers

The abortion industry detests anyone who provides free services to women who want and need help. And they have placed pregnancy centers in the crosshairs.

Again, the rabidly pro-abortion American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists attacks pregnancy centers, accusing them of being "run by people who operate unethically and with the intention to dissuade, deter, or prevent them from seeking certain reproductive health care options."

ACOG is an organization that is supposed to care for two patients—mother and unborn child, but their primary concern is making sure mothers don't have access to alternatives.

The abortion industry and its allies in the Democrat party have encouraged the Federal Trade Commission to prohibit what they call "deceptive and misleading information" by the pregnancy centers.

They have asked Google to limit search results so the pregnancy centers don't show up.

Massachusetts appropriated \$1 million for a statewide advertising campaign designed to destroy pregnancy centers.

Pro-abortion Democrat state attorneys general are organizing to protect abortion by over-regulating pregnancy centers.

Pregnancy centers, the loving arms of the pro-life movement, are under attack.

What this all indicates—not wanting women to get information that might dissuade them from going through with the abortion, not wanting women to know about abortion pill reversal, wanting to shut down and/or censor pregnancy centers —is that "choice" is no longer an option.

We need to fight this destructive mentality, but we also need to pray. For these people, the only acceptable outcome for pregnancy is a dead baby. No choice allowed.
