DISTRICT GOALS:

- During the 2025-2026 school year, increase content mastery weighted proficiency by 8% (67% to 75%) on the **ELA Milestones EOG and EOC (grades 3 - 12)** assessments.
- During the 2025-2026 school year, increase content mastery weighted proficiency by 3% (74% to 77%) on the **Math Milestones EOG and EOC (grades 3 - 12)** assessments.
