Look out for St Marys and Evelyn on TV 1 Seven Sharp on Wednesday at 7.00pm

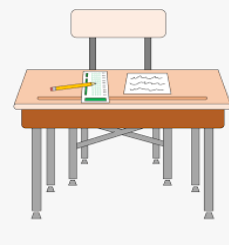

The sacrament of confirmation is the third sacrament of initiation into the Catholic faith.
