- Review of Income & Expense Report from September
- Upcoming expenses will be ice installation items, bar opening needs, and cleaning supplies.
- Terry is working on contacting our vendors to understand how our invoicing and payment processes work with them and update contact information
- Received \$500 income from Pull Tabs last season. Bartenders would love to know as boxes are taken if they are over or short so they can adjust and help manage.
- Ice ads have started to be invoiced through square and we have already received our first payment. Square is able to create quotes/estimates for people like BSU who need purchase order approvals before paying/committing to ads.

- Square account has been upgraded for better security.
- Looking to purchase additional key fobs. Will purchase either 6 or 12 and are \$7.95/piece. Will continue to offer this as an option on the membership form. Dave knows how to program and will show a few others.
- Dave and Rob are working on a Password Safe to help keep all our information secure and in one location.
- Cash and coins in places around the club will be compiled and deposited before season starts. There will be a supply in the safe of cash and coins for bartenders to make change during the season.

- Dave will work with First National Bank to get the club a Debit Card which will help make purchases easy to track and eliminate the need for misc. cash on hand.

Janitor:

- Cathy has been contacting cleaning companies in town to get quotes for services
- We paid Eric \$7,800 a season for cleaning services
- Busy Bee Cleaning provided quote: M-Thur \$85/day. Just the lobby would be \$45. Events would be charged by the hour; \$40/hr for 1 person, \$60/hr for two.
- Cathy will be meeting with Marias Cleaning next week which will allow us to compare.

Ice Maker:

- Talked with Isiah who also received an offer from the BCA. He has not decided yet between the two.
- Jordan developed a graphic to share on social platforms and will remove the salary amount before posting.
- When we have settled on a dollar amount we would then be able to post with the Pioneer and Indeed.
- We will continue to get creative talking with members about a volunteer ice crew, sharing ice techs with other clubs, etc.

Ice Plant:

- The plant will be started on the 28th.
- We are clear to clean mechanical room.
- Electrician has picked up all items, DI Tanks have been delivered to PSM.
- Will continue to move forward!
