- 8. How clean is your city? What are the sanitation programs in your city?
- 9. If you wanted to make your city more environmentally friendly, what could you do?
- 10. Are there enough places for everyone in your city to live?
- 11. Is the population of your city growing? If so, are arrangements being made to provide housing for all the new people coming into your city?
- 12. Are there enough jobs for everyone in your city? What could be done to help the employment rate of your city?
- 13. How safe is the drinking water in your city? Does everyone in your city have access to clean drinking water?
