

PLANS | Participant Stipends and In-Kind Time

PLANS is designed to provide support to multiple participants in order to deepen the implementation of school improvement initiatives that increase student **English**Language Arts (ELA) and math outcomes, strengthen collegial and instructional practices for educators and leaders, and increase retention rates for school leaders.

The **short amounts of time** (e.g. 90-minute sessions) and **diverse ways of engaging** (e.g. in-person, virtual, and asynchronously in an online platform) aim to support the needs of busy educators and stakeholders while providing the needed support to reach the outcomes.

The **financial stipends** honor the time participants spend working with other participants, especially outside school hours and days. The **in-kind time** provided by participants is to implement PLANS to improve their school and their student outcomes. The Education and Innovation Research (EIR) grant that funds PLANS requires matching funds. The in-kind support is the way PLANS meets this requirement while improving outcomes for schools.

- Our research partner, AIR, will invite 8 people across all the PLANS schools to join an <u>Evaluation Advisory Council</u>. Members will be given a \$300 honorarium annually.
