

Reopening Protocol for Pasadena On-Campus Classes

Fuller Theological Seminary is committed to supporting academic excellence both online and in person. We are in the process of a phased reopening to serve and keep our students and employees safe and healthy. We regularly assess public health guidance for on-campus instruction related to classroom density, mask wearing, and social distancing. The City of Pasadena higher educational protocols and Fuller's Reopening Protocol for Institutions of Higher Education are also applicable. These protocols are subject to change with any new guidance that may be released.

During this phased reopening, standard safety protocols must still be observed. Faculty and students must complete Symptom Checks before arriving. Masks and physical distancing will continue to be required, regardless of vaccination status. We have already been in the first phase—providing fully online class offerings. Beginning Summer 2021, on-campus courses will resume on the Pasadena campus. Students are encouraged to enroll in the learning modality that best meets their needs.

PHASE TWO – Primarily online class offerings with limited and modified on-campus classes offered.

WHEN - Summer Quarter 2021

- The majority of courses will remain online but certain classes will be hosted on-campus with a schedule that minimizes interaction
- Selected classrooms will be oversized based on the projected enrollment, with a current limit of 50% of posted classroom occupancy capacity. Chairs may be removed to support physical distancing. In rooms with fixed seating, please skip at least three chairs and sit at least every other row. These classrooms will allow for remote student access as well.
- All participants are required to wear masks.
- Regular cleaning protocols have been implemented and will be maintained.
- Food and beverages will not be allowed in classrooms, with the exception of water.

PHASE THREE – Classes resume with normal online and on-campus scheduling. WHEN – Fall Quarter 2021

- Courses typically taught in-person will be hosted on-campus.
- Classrooms will be scheduled to allow for full occupancy.
- Regular cleaning protocols have been implemented and will be maintained.
- Food and beverages will not be allowed in classrooms, with the exception of water.
