Intended Audience: Student grades 3-4 at FLC.

Technology: Use [Smore.com](https://smore.com) to create your online poster. (*Sign up with Google*).

Requirements:

- Content should be focused on Internet safety tips for the intended audience
- Include **pictures** and **videos** that are kid friendly
- Should include **content discussed in class** and **resources shared**
- Should discuss **social media**
- The poster must include be free of spelling & grammar errors
- Should be attractive and well organized.
- Should be thorough and representative of three days of class work
