Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 9:02 am with quorum established.

Public Comment

- Parents stated appreciation of community involvement with the school, including a recent in-school water tasting sponsored by a local health organization.
- Parents expressed concern with bus transportation issues.

Action Items

- Approval of November agenda.
- Approval of October minutes.

Discussion Items

- Parents would like teacher feedback of student homework.
- Question was posed to parents as to how many parents do receive teacher feedback on student homework & how many parents see homework come home.
- Parents noted the imbalance of homework provided by teachers.
- Parents asked about how some students are given homework on technology which is

sent home, whereas other students do not have homework on their technology and tech is not sent home.

- Parents were reminded although the county is no longer providing internet Hot Spots, parents can contact Xfinity Internet Essentials, in which the contact information is provided on Class Dojo.
- Parents would like more support with student homework in which it was stated to reach out to their children's teacher for direct conversations and solutions.
- Parents were concerned when they assist with homework, parents' question processes and solutions may be different than what was taught by the teacher, making the student's work incorrect. The parents want feedback so they can better understand and assist their children.
- Parents were encouraged to utilize classes offered by the county for additional parent support.
- Changes and improvements are happening and will continue to evolve over time.
- Concerns were mentioned of inconsistency of teacher communication/response on Class Dojo.
