

Guidelines for Plant Products Project Poster (Year-8)

Objective:

To create a poster that shows how useful different plant products are in our daily lives by using **real plant samples** along with your **own drawings**.

Instructions:

1. Choose Plant Products

- Select at least **5 plant products** (e.g., rice, cotton, tea leaves, spices, fruits, vegetables, herbs, wood, etc.).
- Make sure they are safe, clean, and suitable for sticking on paper.

2. Poster Layout

- Title: Write a clear and creative title for your poster.
- Organize your poster neatly (you may divide into sections for each plant product).
- Use both **real plant samples** (small parts like dried leaves, seeds, peels, cotton) and **drawings** to represent the products.

3. Information to Include (for each product)

- **Name of the plant/product**
- **Part of the plant used** (root, stem, leaf, flower, seed, fruit, etc.)
- **Uses in daily life** (food, medicine, clothing, decoration, etc.)
- **Drawing** that shows how it is used

4. Creativity & Presentation

- Decorate your poster with colors, borders, and neat labels.
- Arrange plant products and drawings in an attractive way.
- Be original — use your own ideas, styles, and designs.

5. Safety & Care

- Only use small, dry, or lightweight samples (avoid fresh/wet items that can rot).
- Handle scissors and glue carefully.

6. Submission Details
