

Echo Lake Elementary PTA After-School Clubs Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) 2025-2026

What are After-School Clubs?

- Clubs are enrichment programs that are organized by the PTA.
- They are run by outside vendors and we have a variety of offerings based on student interest, vendor availability, and space at school to hold the clubs.

How Do I Sign Up For Clubs?

- Visit 6Crickets.com or scan the QR code on the club flyer
 - If you do not have an account, please create an account and add your child under your profile.
 - If you already have an account, please make sure your student's information is up to date prior to each registration.



How Do I Find The Echo Lake Clubs On 6Crickets?

- Look for “search for program”
- Select “at your school”
- Choose “Echo Lake Elementary, Shoreline, WA”
- You should now be able to view the available programs. Click on a program to view full details.

What Clubs Are Available?

- Each session has a flyer that has an overview of all our programs.
 - Past clubs have included: Chess, LEGO Robotics, Art, Hip Hop, Spanish Language
- Club offerings are currently for grades 2-5, unless noted otherwise. *UPDATE FOR SPRING SESSION: We now have a couple offerings for Kindergarten and First Grade students! See 6crickets for details.
- You can view details and important information about each club on 6Crickets.com.
- If you are waitlisted or are unable to join the PTA Clubs, please know that there are other club offerings through the school, some are free or paid. Please ask the school office or your child's teacher for available offerings. Some examples include Homework Club, Crochet Club, Girls on the Run, and Fall/Spring Run Club.

When Does Registration Start?

- The registration for Spring Session 2026 is **Monday, March 9th at 10 am** on a FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED basis. Club capacity is limited by each vendor, but they tend to fill up very quickly.
- It is recommended that you add clubs to your cart and complete the forms on 6Crickets in advance, then check out when registration opens to simplify and speed up registration when it opens.

When Do Clubs Start/Finish?

- Visit 6Crickets.com for start and end dates and times for each club.
- Each club has a slightly different schedule, but generally they start 5-10 minutes after school ends and run for 60-90 minutes.
- Each club has a different number of sessions, usually for 6-10 weeks. Clubs do not meet when there is no school. Details are listed under each club on the 6Crickets website.

Can I Volunteer? What Are The Benefits?

- Each club DEPENDS on 1-2 adult volunteers to be present at each session as a chaperone.
- Volunteers must have completed a Shoreline School District background check to be eligible. (*Sorry, no high school students can volunteer as official club chaperones; however, you may be able to provide additional support to earn volunteer hours.*)

- Parent volunteer(s) may receive a discount off their student's club fee and are guaranteed a spot for their student. We request that each volunteer commits to attending the entire session, unless different arrangements are made in advance with the PTA Clubs Committee.

Are Scholarships Available? How can I find out if I'm eligible?

- Yes, we have a limited number of partial and full scholarships available for each club.
- There is no need to provide financial information or proof of need for scholarships! Just simply apply.
- Echo Lake PTA works closely with the Family Advocate to ensure that we offer enrichment programs and scholarships equitably.
- We are using a lottery system to award scholarships. You will need to fill out a basic form for entry into the lottery. The Clubs Committee will notify every scholarship applicant of the results of the lottery and provide information on how to register for the club with the scholarship funds.
