Performance Expert Position Explanation

The purpose of a Performance Expert is to assist Visual and Performing Arts programs. This position is hired as a part-time, short-term hourly basis.

Performance Experts are not required to nbe college students nor Paraeducator Proficient, but will go through standard GUHSD Hiring procedures. Before the Performance Expert can begin work, they must complete the new hire paperwork packet, online-required courses, obtain a TB test, fingerprint clearance and receive their official badge from HR.

Brass and Wind Specialist Description

Under the general supervision of a certificated teacher, the Brass and Wind specialist will develop the woodwind and brass component of the instrumental program while providing musical leadership to members of the Instrumental Music Program.

Common Expectations:

1. Conduct group rehearsals and instruct and coach members in their individual parts, in the fundamentals of musicianship, and ensemble performance
2. Initiate, facilitate, and moderate classroom and after school rehearsal and activities
3. Evaluate students technical skills
4. Contribute to a sequential instrumental program in all divisions by encouraging performance and providing enrichment opportunities.
5. Assists groups in regular and special performances for school program, community activities and festivals
6. Maintain inventories of Brass and Wind supplies, materials and equipment, ensuring all equipment and instruments are in good working order.
7. Other duties as assigned by the Principal or Band Director
