Hi Future Golden Eagle Families:

With a tentative 4 Year plan in mind, it is time for students to select their Freshman year courses. As we talked about last time, all Del Oro students have eight classes, four in the fall and four in the spring. Freshman students are automatically enrolled in English 9, Integrated Math 1, Life Skills, and PE 9. They must choose between Global Systems Science and Ag Earth Science for their freshman science course. Freshmen must also choose from either Spanish 1 or ASL 1 for their World Language course.

Using the [Grade 9 Course Choice Options Sheet](#) as a guide of all of the additional courses that are available to freshmen, students will choose 2 more classes. It's recommended that in order to complete their schedule students consider taking a CTE Intro course, a Visual and Performing Arts course, a support class, or an additional academic course. Students should also select 3 additional courses that will be used as alternates in case their first choice options are unavailable. It is important that students choose different courses for their alternates - choosing the same course multiple times limits the options available, which could mean that an alternate course is chosen for your student.

You and your student will then fill out the [Del Oro Freshman Course Choice Google Form](#) to enter these choices into the system. Keep in mind that the choices selected now influence the master schedule, so please be both thoughtful and thorough in your selections.
