ESSENTIAL EQUIPMENT FOR ALL PUPILS

Pupils have a daily responsibility to come prepared for all subjects' lessons with the correct equipment. They should bring a minimum of a pen, a pencil, a rubber, a ruler and a scientific calculator. The scientific calculator needs to have a 2 or 4-line textbook-style display (sometimes called WriteView). We would recommend a Sharp EL-W531TL or a Casio FX-991CW.

Other stationery that is also required includes coloured pencils, sharpeners, highlighter pens, a mini-whiteboard, pen and eraser and a pair of headphones for their device. Please note that these items will not be provided by the school.

More specialised requirements are noted under specific subject headers.

Due to restrictions in the availability of charging facilities within the school, many devices, as they get older, may struggle to hold enough charge for a whole day of school work. As such, one way to elevate this issue is for pupils to carry a 'power bank'. These are typically large chargeable batteries that can charge another device.

When looking to purchase a power bank please keep the following in mind:

- Ensure you buy a robust unit - they will likely get bashed around in bags
- Ensure the power bank has enough capacity for at least 1 full charge. A typical iPad or laptop has a capacity of between 6000-8000mAh, and phones have slightly less.
- If it is not a phone or iPad that will be charging, ensure the power bank has an appropriate output capacity in Watts to support the device you are charging. Most laptops require between 90W-120W, but you can check what your specific device requires easily by looking online.
- Ensure the power bank has the appropriate connector for the device you intend to charge. Most will have a USB slot and/or a USB-C cable, but not all devices are chargeable on these connectors. If in doubt, check the specifications of the device you will be charging.
