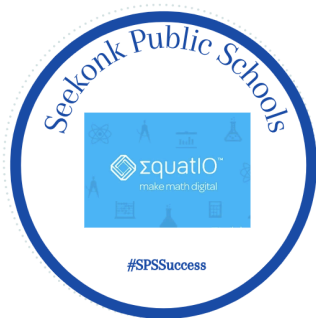


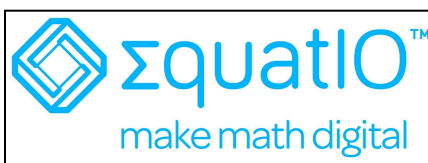
EquatIO Badge



The Badge: The EquatIO badge is issued to individuals who have demonstrated their ability to utilize the extension to support their role in the district. Badge owners will be able to demonstrate the features of EquatIO and reflect on how the features could support students.

How to earn this badge: To earn the EquatIO badge you must demonstrate your ability to use the extension that includes the criteria listed below.

- ☐ Create a document or screencast that includes your evidence.
- ☐ Demonstrate or describe how to use the equation editor.
- ☐ Demonstrate or describe how to use the handwriting tool.
- ☐ Demonstrate or describe how to use the speech tool.
- ☐ Demonstrate or describe how to insert a desmos graph.
- ☐ Demonstrate or describe how to use the screenshot reader.
- ☐ Demonstrate or describe how to use the EquatIO Mathspace.
- ☐ If submitting a document as evidence, include screenshots.
- ☐ Describe how you can/have/will use EquatIO within your role in the district.
- ☐ Submit a link to the publicly shared recording or document as evidence.

- ☐ If you currently hold an [EquatIO](#) certification from Texthelp, provide proof of your current status as well as details on how using EquatIO for Google Chrome has improved your role in the district. Evidence can be a written narrative or in video form. Please submit a link to your evidence below.
