Principal/Vice Principal Update:

- Twin flames concert, well received by the staff and kids
 - Funding was from an Indigenous grant that was applied for.
- Projected enrollment (539, with an anticipated 30 more students) total 569
 - Which might mean 1-2 extra portals
- The Public School board decisions re: zoning might have an impact on the enrollment at SKT.
