1.	Your title and abstract are FREE of symbols, special characters, footnotes, or math.	
2.	The authors' names in the authors list DO NOT contain any numbers.	
3.	You have the correct template for your paper size. (Manuscript templates: IEEE Manuscript Templates for Conference Proceedings IEEE) NOTE: IEEE conference templates contain guidance text for composing and formatting conference papers. Please ensure that all template text is removed from your conference paper prior to submission to the conference. Failure to remove template text from your paper may result in your paper not being published.	
4.	The whole paper, including figures and tables, is in English and should be legible.	
5.	All the sections are in the correct sequence. No missing sections.	
6.	Figure Labels: If including units in the label, present them within parentheses. Do not label axes only with units. For example, write "Magnetization (A/m)", not just "A/m".	
7.	Place figures and tables at the top and bottom of columns. Avoid placing them in the middle of columns. Large figures and tables may span across both columns.	
8.	Reference number: Refer simply to the reference number, as in [3]. Do not use "Ref. [3]" or "reference [3]" except at the beginning of a sentence.	
9.	Reference list: You must include the page numbers and month of publication of journal and conference articles; include the issue number of journal articles. If there are no page numbers, you can include the DOI instead.	
10.	Equation: Use "(1)", not "Eq. (1)" or "equation (1)", except at the beginning of a sentence.
