For **each** story, you are encouraged to do the following:

• Read and annotate the entire text, focusing *specifically* on Poe's overall **message/meaning** conveyed in the story and the **rhetorical choices**\* he makes in order to convey that message/meaning to his readers.

\*rhetoric is the art of effective or persuasive speaking/writing, especially the use of figures of speech and other writing techniques. THINK the power of words!

\*rhetorical choices refer to literally ANYTHING the author does in the text to create/convey meaning; these can be specific literary/figurative devices, such as repetition, hyperbole, metaphor, simile, allusion, etc. but they do not need to be a specific literary device.

#### Final **Assignment** to be submitted in class on **Tuesday**, **July 29th**:

- Choose **one** of the three stories to complete either a **poster** or Google slide **presentation** in which you include the following information:
  - > Title and author of the story
  - > Author's overall **message** conveyed in the story
  - A minimum of 4 rhetorical choices made throughout the story in order to convey the overall message; include <u>specific textual evidence</u> for each choice and clearly explain the **effect** of each choice.
  - ➤ Poster/presentation must be visually appealing: clear, legible font(s) and well chosen organization, text colors, backgrounds, and images (when appropriate).
