How to Find Music to Play in MakeMusic

Method 1: "Dori"

- 1. From the home screen, select Power Me Up.
- 2. Choose your level:
 - o 6th Grade → Level 1
 - o 7th & 8th Grade → Level 2
- 3. Pick a song and play!

Method 2: Search Function

- 1. From the home screen, click the magnifying glass (Music Catalog).
- 2. On the Explore screen, scroll or use filters.

Suggested Filter Settings:

- Difficulty Level
 - 6th → Beginning / Very Easy
 - 7th → Beginning / Very Easy / Easy
 - 8th → Very Easy / Easy / Medium Easy
- Genre → Choose your favorite style, or leave blank to see all!

Practice Strategies

- 10 Minute Practice Session Guide
- 20 Minute Practice Session Guide
- Find a consistent place and time to practice
- When in MakeMusic Always use Play (green button) or Record (red button) so the metronome is on and your progress is tracked.
- Metronome → Slow the tempo down to learn accurately. Speed it up as you improve.
- Loop It → Use the loop feature to practice and perfect just 1–4 measures at a time.
- Chunk It → Break music into small sections (1–4 measures) instead of always starting at the beginning.
- Count & Clap → Say or clap rhythms before playing them. (Try clapping along while MakeMusic plays Your Part.)
- Listen First → Use the My Part feature to hear how it should sound. Practice fingerings or play along slowly with the metronome.
- Mark It Up → Don't write on your Chromebook—write in your music! Add note names, fingerings, sharps/flats, or anything else that helps you get it right.
- My Part
 - Brass Players buzz along with 'my part' playing along with you
 - o Do the fingerings/slide positions while 'my part' plays your part.
