- Teachers will learn how playlists can be implemented.

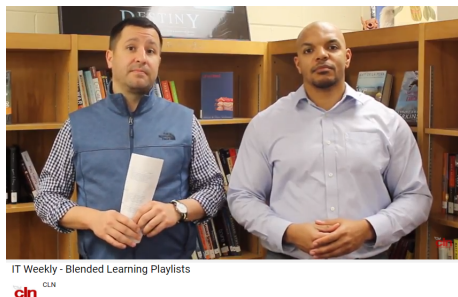
