BIBLE NOTES:

- Truth is Truth. The word remnant doesn't mean chosen. It means what's left of. Satan is always trying to set traps designed to pull believers out of God's kingdom. In this war, we can get killed. The enemy wants to break us and get us to deny life, which is the Word of God. Paul says don't be ignorant of Satan's devices. (2 Corinthians 2:11).
- Whether we acknowledge it or not, we are enlisted in a spiritual war.

Strongholds

- Strongholds are not physical things; they are mental battles that exist in our heads and exalts itself above the knowledge of who God is and what He will do.
- Strongholds must be submitted to Christ.
- Your salvation does not exonerate you from the ability of the enemy to set up strongholds in our head all designed to pull us out the walk.

The victory we have over strongholds

- Jesus overcomes every stronghold. There is victory over every stronghold through Jesus Christ. The problem is we don't believe it.
- In spiritual war, we have guaranteed victory through Christ. Our job is to believe that victory has been guaranteed and to stand and enforce it (Ephesians 6:13).
- Keep standing your ground and look to the cross where victory is enforced.
- Satan refuses to concede defeat, but we have to assert that the enemy has lost (Ephesians 1:17-22, John 10:10).
- Christianity is failing because we don't know how to enforce the victory already won by Christ and because we don't know how to use our weapons.
- There's a spiritual weapon for every stronghold.

Our Armor of God and Spiritual weapons

- Belt of **truth**
- Breastplate of **righteousness**
- Shoes of the **Gospel of peace**
- Shield of **faith**
- Helmet **Salvation**
- **Sword of the Spirit which is the Word of God.** The Word of God is the most powerful weapon we have. Jesus quoted the word of God in encountering the devil. Use the Word of God when the voices of come. Knowing His word, allows you to use it. Immediately find a Word to counter the lies of the enemy.
- **Praise and worship:** The greater the level of worship, the greater the presence of God; Anytime you feel isolated and lonely, praise and worship God.

- **Pray in the spirit:** Acts 2:4, 11, 1 Corinthians 14, Romans 8:26, Acts 19:6
- **Prayer:** talking to God; study the Lord's prayer, Psalm 91, the Book of Acts prayers; use the different types of prayers in the Bible to learn what kind of prayer to pray in different situations
- **The blood of Jesus:** Revelation 12:11, Ephesians 2:13
- **The name of Jesus:** Philippians 2:10
- **Angels:** Hebrews 1:14, Psalm 34:7
- **Brothers and Sisters in Christ:** we are all weapons for each other (John 17:21, John 13:35, Mark 6:7-13)
- **Knowledge:** Isaiah 4:6
- **Fasting:** Psalm 69:10
- **Truth:** John 14:6
