Key Research & Discussion Areas

Planning and Preparation

- How will you acquire the information necessary to take on the analysis?
- Consider the Policy objective and see if the contents of the Policy achieves the objective(s).
- How is the Policy implemented?
- How is it evaluated?
- Who is responsible for modifying/ renewing the aspects of the policy?
- How often would you recommend for the policy to be reviewed?
- Any recommendations on improving the Policy?

Design

- How would you present your findings?
- What format would you use to communicate your recommendations?
- Explore other global organizations and look into their Emergency Response and Crisis Management policy and mirror it with the Think Pacific's policy. Is there

anything you'd change? Or include?

Proposal

- It would be helpful to emphasize within the proposal that your ideas are suggestions that can be expanded upon by those within the organization.
- It may be worth including 'literature' used in some sort of resource sheet. This could be used not only for reference but if the organization wants to read further into the sources you have used.
- How will your presentation add value to what in itself should be quite self-explanatory as a business policy document?

Evaluation

- Are the objectives that you have set ambitious but achievable?
- What method of evaluation will you use to evaluate the success of the suggestions and research? When should this evaluation take place?
- Read through the policy from your target reader's perspective, does it make sense?
- Did you achieve the targets you had set yourself at the beginning. Are the main points covered?

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
