

Fredon School has begun utilizing Pick Up Patrol to help manage our dismissal process! Pick Up Patrol provides a layer of safety to our dismissal process by authorizing plan changes and automatically tracking student dismissal plans. The application reduces interruptions, speeds up dismissal time and is administered by our own staff. Please use Pickup Patrol for any changes to your child(ren)'s schedule.


