**Key Text:** Joshua 23.14 (ESV)

14 “And now I am about to go the way of all the earth, and you know in your hearts and souls, all of you, that not one word has failed of all the good things that the LORD your God promised concerning you. All have come to pass for you; not one of them has failed.

**Key Word:** Inheriting the Promise, God is Faithful

  - a. Each tribe's allotment
3. Living in the Land (23-24)
  - a. 24.15 - Choose this day..

Conquering the Land (1-12)

- Preparation to conquer (1-5)
- Dividing and Conquering (6-11.15)
  - Israel takes the middle land, dividing the country.
  - Then there is a southern campaign, followed by a northern campaign.
- Recording the conquest (11.16-12.24)
