About this course: Taught by Mrs. Rachel Spencer, ERA High School Chorus & Piano Teacher, Group Piano Lessons allows 5-12 grade ERA students to learn beginner piano skills in a group setting. Mrs. Spencer teaches a lesson out of the book, assigns songs for students to work on, and then students practice the songs (wearing headphones so they hear just their own piano) while Mrs. Spencer circulates. At the end of class, students will review what they learned and get assigned a short "homework" assignment in the book (easily completed in 5-10 minutes outside of class). This class is ideal for BEGINNERS, but could also be great for kids who had lessons for a year in the first grade and then quit, and now wish they hadn't. This could also be a great class for kids who have taught themselves how to play some things by ear, but don't know how to read music. This is <u>not</u> an ideal class for kids who have taken piano lessons for multiple years. Registration Information for parents: Register your child HERE by Thursday, January 9, 2025 at 5pm. The first ten students to sign up have priority, and any other students who register past that will join the waitlist. If we don't get at least 6 students to sign up, the class will not run. Transportation & timing details:

- Lower school students not enrolled in ERA after school:
 - On Tuesdays and Thursdays (detailed on the calendar below), meet Officer Huffman when HS walkers are released and walk over to the upper school in a group.
 - Wait in the commons until 3:25. This time can be spent doing homework, reading a book, etc.
 - At 3:30, enter the piano lab (room 301). The first couple of times, Mrs. Spencer will definitely come out to help piano students find the room!
 - The lesson runs from 3:35-4:05pm.
 - At 4:05pm, students will exit the closest door, shown on the map on the next page. Parents should arrange for their child to be picked up by 4:10pm sharp.
- Lower school students enrolled in ERA after school:
 - Same as above, and then...
 - At 4:05pm, students will exit the closest door and walk back to the lower school to continue with after school programming.
- Upper school students:
 - Come directly to the piano lab (301) after school on Tuesdays and Thursdays

More details about payments (how to pay, etc) will be shared with registered families by Jan 13th.

<u>Recommended Materials</u>: piano or electronic piano keyboard to practice on at home. Things to look for in an electric keyboard:

- 88 keys (full size- not all keyboards have all 88 keys)
- Sustain Pedal (used to blend sounds together)
- Music stand (to prop the music up so you can see it)
- Weighted, touch-sensitive keys (this makes it feel like a "real" piano)
- Piano stand (to literally hold the piano keyboard up)

The "fine print":

- There are no refunds given for missed lessons (even if your child is sick, has an appointment, or any
 other reasons). If you need to cancel lessons (your child gets into a sport, your schedule changes, or
 they change their mind), please give two weeks notice so Mrs. Spencer can find another student to take
 your child's spot.
- This is <u>not</u> an official ERA endorsed class. No course credit will be given. It <u>has</u> been approved by ERA administration as an extracurricular activity (with an associated fee).
- Mrs. Spencer is allowed one canceled lesson per semester without providing a refund to families. If she
 needs more than one canceled lesson during the course of the semester, refunds will be provided
 and/or payment schedules will be adjusted accordingly.
- If Mrs. Spencer needs to cancel a lesson, she will give as much notice as possible so you can prepare for your child's transportation needs.
- If it's "not working out" with a student (they're extremely disruptive or destructive, they show zero interest in learning the piano, etc), Mrs. Spencer reserves the right to stop teaching that student (she would refund any lessons paid for that then would be unused). She does not expect this to be a problem!:)
