My Identity

I am fully armored today so when I go about my business, my body, soul, and spirit are all entirely clad with the whole armor of God. Ephesians 6:10-17

Ephesians 6 full passage

I am strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. I put on the full armor of God today, and I take my stand against the devil's schemes. For my struggle is not against people, but against spiritual forces in the heavenly realms. Therefore I put on the full armor of God, and stand my ground. I stand firm then, with the BELT OF TRUTH buckled around my waist, with the BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS in place and with my feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the GOSPEL OF PEACE. In addition to all this, I take up the SHIELD OF FAITH, with which I can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. I take the HELMET OF SALVATION and I wield the SWORD OF THE SPIRIT, which is the WORD OF GOD. Ephesians 6:10-17
