We added support for **seeing and adjusting the deadline for multiple requests** of the same conditional document. Requesters now see previously sent requests & the existing deadline, allowing them to choose whether to extend the deadline. Instructional text and greyed out dates support choosing appropriate deadlines.

**Deadline**

Jul 9, 2025

Deadline must be after today's date and no more than 6 months out. The deadline cannot be changed to an earlier date after the request is made.

A **new report block for Conditional documents** lists applicants who meet the condition along with whether they have had the request made of them, and whether they have provided the file. This block can be added to reports using the Approval PDF templates admin tool.

From the applicant grid, you can now **bulk request conditional documents**. The bulk request modal provides details on which applicants will be sent the request. Applicants will be omitted if they do not meet the necessary conditions for the request, if they have a terminal status, or if they have already provided the file.

If you do need to **request a document of an applicant at a terminal status**, you can do so via the request modal on that applicant's hoverboard. We now **ask for confirmation** before sending the request in this case, as applicants who are hired, withdrawn, or have declined an offer should not need to provide additional information for the hiring process.

Request documents

Conditional documents can be requested from applicants when they meet the criteria established in the search plan. An email will be sent to each applicant asking for the document. The email will contain a link allowing them to quickly log in and provide a file.
