- 3) How did you become interested in becoming a member at CLC?
- 4) What is the gospel? (just your short, simple, understanding)
- 5) How and when did you come to believe the gospel?
- 6) What are some ways that God has changed you since you believed the gospel?
- 7) Have you been baptized?
- 8) If yes, where and when were you baptized (close as you can get)?
- 9) Can you affirm our Statement of Faith?
- 10) Can you commit to our Mission?
- 11) Our Membership Commitments?
- 12) Are there any questions you have with regards to membership at CLC?
- 13) Are you attending a CLC class or Home Group? If so, which one?
- 14) Are you currently a member at another church? If so, which one? If you joined here, would you be leaving on good terms?
