## Warm This Winter Grants

### What we fund:

Warm This Winter is a new campaign demanding the government acts now to help people struggling with energy bills this winter and to ensure we all have access to affordable energy in the future. The campaign focuses on four clear demands **aimed at the government:**

- ⇒ Emergency support for vulnerable households
- ⇒ An ambitious, nation-wide energy efficiency programme
- ⇒ A rollout of onshore wind generation
- ⇒ An end to offshore oil and gas expansion

We hope to support community groups to organise local events and activities that help to build public and political support for the demands aimed at the government. We are especially interested in supporting groups working in the areas of fuel poverty, housing, disability rights, climate justice, or on alternative solutions (e.g. energy co-ops).

### The kind of activity/ events we want to support:

In your [application](#) we ask that your event/ activity meets *ONE* of the following

- Led by or in partnership with groups who have experience of fuel poverty or are especially vulnerable to fuel poverty.
- Led by local groups to create public engagement with the campaign.
- Led by local groups to engage politicians and/or councillors with the campaign.

We are especially interested in events and activities in the following areas: Bridgend, Bishop Auckland, Hemel Hempstead, Mansfield, North Thanet, Stoke-on-Trent South and North, Rugby, South Northamptonshire, Norwich North, Bury North (Greater Manchester), Kensington, NW Durham, Dewsbury, Birmingham (Northfield), Wolverhampton South West, Aberconwy, Keighley, Peterborough, Hyndburn, Pudsey, Blackpool South, West Bromwich West, Harlow.

If your event or activity takes place in a location with existing Warm This Winter-related activity, we ask that you take existing activity to a new level.

- **Small Grant:** £200 to £500
- **Medium Grant:** £500 to £5,000
- **Large Grant:** £5,000 to £10,000

You can apply if you are a:	We cannot accept applications from:

  - ~~Successful candidates will be informed by 15th November 2022~~
- **Small & Medium grants:** Reviewing these on a monthly basis until 1 January
  - Applications received by the end of each month will be reviewed and applicants will be informed if they were successful within a month.

**FAQs:**

**Can I apply if my group/organisation isn't in one of the target constituencies listed in the criteria?**

You can apply but applications for activities in target constituencies will be prioritised.

**Does the sub-grant need to be spent before a certain time?**

All sub-grants must be spent before May 2023.

**Can the sub-grant be used for frontline or financial support?**

Sub-grants cannot be used to provide services like these (e.g. food vouchers, financial aid for energy bills). The funds can only be used to build public and political support for the campaign demands aimed at MPs and the government.
