Availability

Lessons are subject to the availability of instructors and practice rooms. As of September 26, 2025, most spots have been filled.

Scheduling

Instructors contact previous students before adding new students.

- Scheduling occurs in this order:
 - Students taking lessons during the 2025-2026 school year
 - Students who began lessons in the summer of 2026
 - New students
- Summit students may request lessons at or after their dismissal time. There are no music lessons during the school day.
- The 3:00 pm and 3:30 pm lessons are the most popular and are usually filled by returning music students.
- The request form below allows parents to list scheduling requests or conflicts, but not all requests can be fulfilled.
- For students not enrolled in Summit Afterschool, parents are responsible for supervision between dismissal and lesson time.
 - Summit parents may have the option to add Afterschool as a holding spot for a student to attend a later lesson. To request a spot in Afterschool, contact Wendy Rice, Director of Summit Afterschool, wrice@summitmail.org. Space is limited.

2024- 2025 Lesson Fees

- \$45 for 30 minutes - 30 minutes is our standard lesson length.
- \$60 for 45 minutes
- \$75 for 60 minutes

- Parents are billed for lessons through Summit.

Equipment

Students should have their own instrument to use for practice. Guitars should be the right size (1/2, 3/4, full) and travel with the student to and from school on lesson days.

Lesson Request for New Music Students

Previous students are given priority in scheduling. Instructors will contact all previous students before adding new students.

- 1- A parent or guardian should fill out the **Music Lesson Request** form [HERE](#) to provide information about your child, his/her availability, experience, and instrument(s) of interest.
- 2- We will use this information to identify a match between student and instructor. If there are no matches available, we will contact you and offer a waitlist option.
- 3- Once we identify a good match, Summit will attempt to schedule the student at a time and day based on parent's request and teacher's availability. The instructor will describe what, if anything, is needed for the first lesson, where to meet, and where to pick up.
- 4- Before the first lesson, a parent/guardian is required to accept the terms of the **Summit Music Lesson Parent Agreement**. To read the terms, go [HERE](#). The Confirmation Form should be completed after lessons are scheduled. You will find the form at the end of the Agreement.
