Upon admission, students will choose to complete their coursework over a two year period or a fast track one year period. Please note that students choosing the fast track must complete a [GPAS Planner](#) and meet with the Director of Graduate Studies as soon as possible in the first semester to map out courses.

### Two Year Coursework Option

- Students earn a degree in a minimum of 24 months.
- Coursework is delivered online.
- A minimum of 30 semester graduate credits must be completed to fulfill degree requirements.
- Students complete two courses (6 credits) each semester. Summer may be used to complete elective credit requirements.
- Students will need to turn in a [GPAS Planner](#) during their first semester.
